The service was opened with a reading of Psalm 150 followed by a Prayer of Praise led by TE JP Sibley. After singing, *Be Lifted*, the presbyters professed the truths of God's Word using Heidelberg Catechism #1, corporately confessed sin and were reminded of God's wonderful pardon from John 10:7-11,3. After singing, *You Know My Name*, an offering was collected and the congregation stood and sang the *Doxology*. TE Sibley read 1 Corinthians 9:19-23 and then preached a message from that passage. After properly fencing the table, TE JP Sibley and various elders served the Lord's Table. The congregation stood and sang, *Nothing But the Blood*. TE Sibley pronounced the benediction from Matthew 10:39 and the presbyters sang, *Let the Church Say, Amen*.

Call to Order

The Seventeenth Stated Meeting of the Lowcountry Presbytery was called to order by the moderator, RE David Walters, Sr. at 10:30AM in the meeting place of the New City Fellowship Church Plant in Orangeburg, SC.

The Moderator, RE David Walters, Sr. opened the meeting with prayer.

Quorum

The moderator asked the Stated Clerk if there was a quorum. The Stated Clerk declared that a quorum was present.

Docket Approval **M/s/C:** that the docket for the 17th Stated meeting of Lowcountry presbytery as submitted by the Administration Committee and posted on the website and electronically distributed to presbyters be approved with amendments to move the consideration of an Overture to the beginning of the docket.

Introduction of Guests Approval of

Minutes

Guests & first-time commissioners were introduced.

M/s/c: that the minutes of the 16th Stated Meeting of Lowcountry Presbytery which met on November 7, 2019 be approved as posted on the website.

M/s/c: that the minutes from the Specially Called Meeting of the Lowcountry Presbytery which met on December 9, 2019 be approved as posted on the website.

M/S/C: to form a Committee as a whole to review the Session minutes of the churches.

Minutes of the various Churches were handed out for review along with a Minutes Review form

Introduction of Guests

Welcomed TE Jeremy Mullen, MTW Missionary Alan Cochet. TE Rob Hamby. Member of New City, Gary Robinson, Barry Sibley. TE Steve Walton from Scots Kirk.

Presentation of Memorials

The Moderator asked if there were any memorials. There were none. **M/S/C**: The Moderator appointed TE Bill Harritt and TE Rob Hamby. to the Committee of Thanks.

Consideration of Overture

TE Payne opened in prayer. An overture was received from the Session of Christ Church Presbyterian Church in Charleston, SC. <u>See Appendix for Overture Text</u>. After some introductory comments the Overture was read.

Motion presented by TE Turner from the Two Rivers Church Session:

Motion: While we appreciate the time and thought that Christ Church invested in preparing the Overture and their desire to protect and maintain the purity of the church regarding the ordination of officers. The Overture raises some very important points that should be discussed and considered carefully and prayerfully. We submit that the individual churches should have more than a week to consider the Overture before it comes to a vote at Low Country Presbytery. We move that we **postpone consideration** of this overture until the April 28, 2020 meeting of Lowcountry Presbytery.

This motion was ruled <u>out of order by the moderator</u> because this would prohibit the Lowcountry Presbytery from acting in a timely manner on this overture before General Assembly deadlines.

Motion to adopt the Overture humbly submitted by the Session of Christ Church Presbyterian Church in Charleston, SC.

Discussion ensued...

Motion by TE Steel and 2nd to postpone consideration of this Overture to a Specially Called meeting to be held on a date to be determined. Favor 11 Against 14 – **Motion failed**.

Back to main motion.

M/S/C: to adopt the Overture humbly submitted by the Session of Christ Church Presbyterian Church in Charleston, SC.

Favor 17 Against 10 – motion carries.

TE Payne closed in prayer.

RE Rich Wylly opened the MNA/MTW report in prayer.

Therefore be it resolved that Lowcountry Presbytery overture the 48th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in America to amend *The Book of Church Order* chapter 17 such that a new clause, *BCO* 17-4, be added which reads as follows (New words underlined):

17-4. Men who self-identify as a "gay Christian," "same sex attracted Christian," and/or "homosexual Christian" shall be deemed unfit for ordination in the Presbyterian Church in America.
